

In English, I will learn...

- How to ask and write questions.
- How to demonstrate understanding of a written text.
- New adventurous vocabulary to use in non-fiction and fictional writing.
- To apply phonics knowledge to a wide range of books.

In Maths, I will learn...

- To recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
- To recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
- To describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three quarter turns
- To tell the time to the hour and half past and draw the hands on a clock to show these times.
- To measure and begin to record time (hours, minutes and seconds)
- To compare, describe and solve practical problems for time (quicker, slower, earlier, later)



In Science, I will learn...

- To identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.
- To identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- To describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals including pets).

In DT, I will learn...

- To be able to explore different ways of joining and strengthening materials to create models of playground equipment.
- To be able to design and make a model of playground equipment
- To be able to evaluate a finished product

In ICT, I will learn...

- To create an animated story book

 - Add a sound
